

Erasmus+

Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth and sport. It offers a range of opportunities for higher education students, doctoral candidates, staff and institutions from around the world. The world is changing fast, and education systems need to modernise and adapt to new ways of teaching and learning and embrace the new opportunities that exist.

What options do I have?

- **Mobility for studies** – studying abroad;
- **Mobility for Traineeship** – doing your internship abroad;
- **Traineeship for Recent Graduates** – doing your internship abroad after graduating from the university (you have to start the internship during one year after the graduation).

When can I go?

As a Higher Education student, you can start your mobility on your second year. Master's students can go on an exchange on their first year, second term.

For how long?

Minimum time of the mobility is 3 months, in case on internship 2 months and maximum is 12 months.

Where can I go?

EU countries + Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey and Former Yugoslavian Republic Macedonia.

You can go and study in a partner university (list of those are on Euroacademy's website).	To some European enterprise or institution (except EU institutions & national foreign missions).

How can I apply?

- 1) Pick a partner university where you want to study (from the list on Euroacademy's website)/pick an European institution for traineeship;
- 2) Download an application form from our website, fill it in and send to erasmus@euroakadeemia.ee;
- 3) Wait an answer from Erasmus Coordinator.

Deadlines:

In case of studies, primary deadline is 15th of March, 1st additional is in May and 2nd additional is in October.

In case of traineeship you have to apply **at least 2 months** before your planned mobility.

Erasmus Grant:

As a participant of Erasmus programme, you will get an European Commission grant (the amount of it depends on the chosen country).
